Every believer is eternally safe and secure in Christ forever! The Bible teaches that a true believer can never lose his salvation and be lost (John 6:37-40). If you are a true believer in Christ, you are really safe and secure in Christ forever (John 10:28).

The new life we have in God ought to be manifested and demonstrated. I need to remember that there is something that every true believer possesses:

- "He that believeth on Me hath (has) eternal life" (John 6:47)
- "And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand." (John 10:28)
- "He is passed from death unto life" (John 5:24)
- "He that hath (has) the Son hath (has) life" (1 John 5:12)

Every true believer possesses life. The person who is not a true believer does not have life (1 John 5:12 and compare Eph. 2:1). He is dead. He breathes and exists and walks and eats, but he does not have the life of God (Ephesians 4:18).
