

Note : Justification does not mean that God MAKES a sinner righteous. If this were true then we would never sin again. A justified person is still a sinner (a sinner saved by grace). God sees the saved person perfectly righteous in Christ.

Ask Him: "Lord, I believe you died for me and I now receive you as my Savior". If you ask Jesus to save you, you will have eternal life as **I John 5:12** says: "He that hath the Son hath life; and he that hath not the Son of God hath not life."
