V. ALL MEN NEED TO BE SAVED BECAUSE THEY ARE <u>BLIND</u>.

A. The unbeliever is blinded by Satan (2 Corinthians 4:4).
In 2 Corinthians 4:4 the devil is called by what name? (Note:
the word "world" should be translated "age"). This verse teaches us that Satan blinds certain people in
order that the light of the gospel might not shine unto them. Are these people believers or unbelievers?
In 2 Corinthians 4:3 there is a word that describes this same group of people. What is that word? According to these verses, does Satan want people to understand and believe the gospel? (<i>Note</i> : the Gospel is the Good News about the Lord Jesus Christsee 1 Corinthians 15:1-4.) Read Luke 8:4-5 and Luke 8:11-12. <u>Verse 12</u> (1 Corinthians chapter 2) What does every believer receive the moment he is saved?
This verse teaches us that God wants us to the
things that are freely to us of God and that is why He has given to us the Holy
to be our Teacher. Do you think that God wants you to know His truth? Read
1 Corinthians 14:20. When it comes to understanding His truth, does God want us to be babies or
grown up?
<u>Verse 13 (1 Corinthians chapter 2)</u> Do we learn God's truth by our own wisdom or by the Holy
Spirit teaching us?
Verse 14 (1 Corinthians chapter 2) The "natural man" is the unsaved person. This verse teaches us
that unsaved men and women are blind when it comes to God's truth. Can the natural man receive the
truths of God's Word? Can he know and understand them? What one word in this
verse shows us what the unsaved man really thinks about God's truth?
Therefore, when you share something from the Bible with an
unsaved person, should you be surprised if he should make fun at you? Should you be
surprised if he can't really understand God's Word? [Do you remember when you were
unsaved? Did you understand the things of God or were you blind? The word that is
translated " <i>natural</i> " in 1 Corinthians 2:14 is the same word that is translated " <i>sensual</i> " in Jude 19.
Thus as we look in the book of Jude, verse 19, we learn that the natural (sensual) man is the man who

HOW IS A PERSON SAVED?

A person is saved by taking God at His Word, by believing that Jesus is the Son of God, that Jesus is God, that Jesus died on the cross for all. The word all includes everyone, and all includes you. If you have never trusted Jesus to save you, why not ask Jesus to save you now?

Ask Him: "Lord, I believe you died for me and I now receive you as my Savior". If you ask Jesus to save you, you will have eternal life as **I John 5:12** says: "He that hath the Son hath life; and he that hath not the Son of God hath not life."

Romans 10:13 "For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved."
